
Ultra Pledge

You will be on active duty for our Lord Jesus Christ in some of Satan's deepest strongholds. You will be immersed into new cultures that have different values than you and there will be a temptation to do things that you normally wouldn't do at home. Remember you are representing Christ and that yourlife should reflect His character.

Correspondence Back Home

Communication with friends and family should be edifying while sharing with them your personal journey. It is important to be culturally sensitive as you are a guest traveling in someone else's country. You will be given additional guidelines regarding email, social media, and photographs during orientation.

Home Church Accountability

GTO expects you to be accountable to your home church and maintain your home church requirements while serving under GTO. If GTO requirements (head veiling, skirts/dresses, etc.) differ from your church's, GTO does ask that you support and practice GTO's requirements while on Ultra.

Personal Accountability

For there to be continued spiritual growth, Ultra allows you to explore your story and depths of your heart you may have not been to before. This will require vulnerability and you allowing your team and leaders to speak into your life.

Confidentiality

You will have the opportunity to be closely involved with the lives and hearts of your team members. Protecting their stories and personal journeys is necessary for trust to be built and a safe environment created.

Undivided Attention

You will need to give your undivided attention and focus to the required assignments while on Ultra, and will need to participate wholeheartedly in team activities. This sometimes will mean giving up things that are taking away your focus. For these reasons, we do not allow dating or romantically attached relationships during the six-month Ultra term.
